

## 4 General Comments

1

- Gutturals **ק ה ע א** take Hateph Pathach (◌ֲ) instead of Vocal Shewa (◌ֻ)
  - But Resh **ר** can take a Vocal Shewa (◌ֻ)
- If a begadkephat with a Dagesh Lene gets a vowel in front of it, the Dagesh goes away.
- Verbs are described with I-, II-, or III- referring to the first, second, or third root consonant.
  - I-guttural has a guttural for the first root consonant.
  - II-guttural has a guttural for the second root consonant.
- Stem vowel = vowel under the second root consonant.

## I-Guttural, II-Guttural (§14.2-14.3)

2

- **WRITE IN HEBREW**
- I-Guttural and II-Guttural refers to **ק ה ע א** as the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> root consonant.
- Same as strong verbs except:
  - Guttural takes Hateph Pathach (◌ֲ) instead of Vocal Shewa (◌ֻ)
- The reason that **ר** is not considered to be a guttural here is that **ר** CAN take a Vocal Shewa.

## III-ק/ע (§14.2-14.3)

3

- **RECOGNITION ONLY**
- III-ק/ע refers to **ק** or **ע** as the 3<sup>rd</sup> root consonant.
- Same as strong verbs except 2fs takes Pathach (◌ֶ) instead of Silent Shewa (◌ֻ).
- This does not follow any rule that you know.

## III-א (§14.4-14.5)

- **RECOGNITION ONLY**
- Use sufformatives to recognize.
- Sufformatives the same as strong except:
  - Lose Dagesh Lene in **ת**
  - Lose Silent Shewa under **ת**
- Stem vowel
  - Qamets (◌ֻ), not Pathach (◌ֶ)

### III-ה (§14.6-14.7)

■ **WRITE IN HEBREW**

- Use the III-ה drill sheet on the website.
- 1. Accent same as strong verb.
- 2. First vowel same as strong verb.
- 3. Drop the 3-ה from the root.
- 4. Stem vowel is יֹ in 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> persons.
- 5. Sufformatives are almost the same.
  - Drop Dagesh Lene in Tau ת → ת
  - Because preceded by vowel.
  - Drop Shewa under Tau ת → ת
  - 3MS ends in הֶ (Was 3FS!)
  - 3FS sufformative תָּה (3MS took it)

### Doubly Weak (I/II-Guttural + III-ה) (§14.8-14.9)

■ **WRITE IN HEBREW**

- Just like a III-ה verb except use Hateph Pathach (ֶֿ) instead of Vocal Shewa (ֶֿ) under guttural (א ע ה הּ).
- ה is not considered to be a guttural here because ה CAN take a Vocal Shewa.

### Geminate Verbs (§14.10-14.11)

■ **RECOGNITION ONLY**

- Geminate Verbs have the same letter for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> root consonants.
- In 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> person, repeated consonant → יֹֿֿ
- Use sufformatives to recognize.
- Sufformatives the same as strong except:
  - Lose Dagesh Lene in ת
  - Lose Silent Shewa under ת

### Biconsonantal Verbs (§14.12-14.13)

■ **RECOGNITION ONLY**

- Biconsonantal has 2 consonants instead of 3.
- In the lexical form, there is a vowel letter between that → Qamets (ֶֿ) in QP3ms
  - קָם → קָם
  - שָּׁם → שָּׁם
  - בָּא → בָּא
  - Like Greek contract verbs (ἀγαπάω → ἀγαπῶ)
- Memorize the lexical form!
  - You need to remember that it is קָם not קָם or קָם
- Use sufformatives to recognize.

## נָתַן (§14.18)

- **RECOGNITION ONLY**
- This is a very common verb.
- נָתַן same as strong verb except
  - If sufformative begins with נ or ת III-נ assimilates to Dagesh.
  - Gains an accent in 2fs
  - Recognize based on sufformatives.

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## הָיָה (§14.18)

- **RECOGNITION ONLY**
- This is a very common verb.
- הָיָה same as I-Guttural + III-הָ except
  - Takes הָ instead of expected הָ under I-הָ in 2mp and 2fp

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## Summary

- For הָ הָ אָ , Vocal Shewa (ְ) → Hateph Pathach (ֶ)
- Recognize from sufformative.
  - If vowel precedes, tau loses Dagesh and Shewa (תָּ → תֶּ)
- Memorize 3-הָ verb paradigm.
- Stem Vowel in lexical form:
  - Usually (ֶ)
  - 3-אָ has (ֶ) (3-הָ has (ֶ) too)
  - Biconsonantal has (ֶ) or (ֶ) or (ֶ)
- Lost a consonant? Look at vowel under 2<sup>nd</sup> root consonant.
  - 3-הָ if (ֶ) in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> person. (3<sup>rd</sup> person gives no clue)
  - Geminate if (ֶ) in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> person. (not lose in 3<sup>rd</sup>)
  - Biconsonantal if (ֶ) in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> person. (3<sup>rd</sup> accented)
  - 3-נָ if (ֶ) in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> person. (not lose in 3<sup>rd</sup>)

- 1 עָלָה עָלוּ 1G+3ה QP 3cp III-ה drops off
- 3 אָכַל אָכְלוּ I-Gutt QP 3cp Same as strong
- 5 שָׁמַע שָׁמְעוּ III-ע QP 2ms Normal (III-ע has Silent Shewa)
- 7 בָּנָה בָּנְתָה III-ה QP 3fs Drop 3ה. 3fs → תָּה
- 9 נָשָׂא נָשְׂאוּ III-א QP 1cs SV וְ . א quiescent. ה loses Dagesh
- 11 רָאָה רָאִיתָהּ 2G+3ה QP 3fs Drop 3ה. 3fs → תָּה. 2G וְ → וְ
- 13 הָיָה הָיְתָה 1G+3ה QP 3fs Drop 3ה. 3fs → תָּה.
- 15 בָּנָה בָּנְנוּ III-ה QP 3cp Drop 3ה. 1cp is בָּנֵינוּ
- 17 רָאָה רָאוּ 2G+3ה QP 3cp Drop 3ה. II-Gutt has no effect here.
- 19 נָתַן נָתְנוּ III-נ QP 3ms Normal (III-נ has no sufformative)
